The details of this award are given below

1. Title of this award will be "Dr. J P Shrivastava Best Teacher Award" 2024.
2. The award will carry a cash prize of 5000/-.
3. It will be an annual award given at the Gold Medal Ceremony of the Institute.
4. The number of the award in a particular year will be one.
5. The award will be coordinated by Dean (Academia)/ Dean (Administration). The award will be given to only Assistant Professors. The application form will be invited by the coordinator, which will be submitted through HOD to the Dean. Thereafter, all nominations will be put to the committee for its final recommendation. The Director of the Institute will approve one name recommended by the committee.
6. The applicant must have at least 3 years of teaching experience as regular faculty member in Institute.
7. The applications will be invited by coordinator every year.
8. The application in prescribed format will be enrouted through proper channel. It will be signed by at least 2 peers from the Institute.
9. The candidate is expected to be a role model teacher with high moral values and must not have been penalized on any enquiry pending against him.
10. The committee will be as follows
 - i. Dean Admin
 - ii. Dean Academics
 - iii. Dean Student welfare
 - iv. Convenor (s) of Gold Medal Ceremony

Decision of the Committee (after approval of the Director) will be final. There will be no appeal against it.
