

NATIONAL CADET CORPS

The National Cadet Corps is the Youth Wing of the Armed Forces with its Headquarters in New Delhi, India. It is open to high school and college students on a voluntary basis.

The National Cadet Corps is a Tri-Services organization, comprising the Army, Navy, and Air Wing, engaged in grooming the youth of the country into disciplined and patriotic citizens. The National Cadet Corps in India is a voluntary organization that recruits cadets from high schools, colleges, and universities all over India. The cadets are given basic military training in small arms and parades.

The officers and cadets have no liability for active military service once they complete their course. The NCC is the world's largest uniformed youth organization. Its motto is "Unity and Discipline".

The NCC in India was formed by the National Cadet Corps Act of 1948. In 1954, the existing tricolor flag was introduced. The three colors in the flag depict the three services in the Corps; red for the Army, deep blue for the Navy, and light blue for the Air Force. The NCC is headed by a Director General with the rank of Lieutenant General.

The organizational structure continues as follows:

- Directorate-There are 17 directorates located in the state capital, headed by an officer of the rank of a major general from each of the three services.
- Division/Regional Corps-There are three such specialized corps located in Mumbai, Delhi, and Bangalore, respectively. They are independent of the state directorate and report to the HQ. These divisions form the support function of the regular NCC. Each is headed by a Senior Under Officer—an equivalent rank to that of a Lieutenant General. Internal Affairs, Administration, Development, and Research: Lt. Gen. [SUO] Arvind Shekhar (New Delhi). Recruitment, Training, Media, and HR: Lt. Gen. [SUO] Prithvi Pant Negi (Mumbai). Special Forces, Infantry, Gallantry Committee & Commendations; Lt. Gen. [SUO] Bhav Salimath (Bangalore).

- Depending upon the size of the state and the growth of NCC in the states, directorates have up to 14 group headquarters under them through which they exercise their command and control of the organization in the state. Each group is headed by an officer of the rank of Brigadier or equivalent known as Group Commander.
- Battalion-Each NCC Group Headquarters controls 5-7 units (Battalions) commanded by a Colonel/Lt. Col or equivalent.

Each battalion consists of companies which are commanded by the Associate NCC Officer (ANO) of the rank of lieutenant to major. In all, there are 96 Group Headquarters in the country who exercise control over a network of 684 Army wing units (including technical and 1st gen units), 60 Naval wing units, and 61 Air Squadrons. There are two training establishments, namely the Officers Training School, Kamptee (Nagpur, Maharashtra) and the Women's Officers Training School, Gwalior. In addition, Vice Chancellors of various universities across India are given the honorary rank of commandant in the NCC in order to promote and support the NCC in their respective universities. For the Army Wing, each battalion or unit of NCC consists of a number of platoons or Boys. For senior division boys, each platoon consists of 52 cadets and each coy consists of 160 cadets. Each BN has 4 to 7 coy, so each BN carries around 640 to 1120 cadets. A senior wing girls BN consists of 2 to 7 coys, for a total of 320 to 1120 cadets. For junior division boys and junior wing girls, each troop has 100 cadets, and each BN has at least one troop. An ANO is an important link in the NCC organization between the BN and the cadets. As a matter of fact, ANO is the feeder node of NCC since he/she is the one who is in direct contact with the cadets all throughout the year. Associate NCC officers are given the following ranks according to their seniority and their training.

For colleges (charged with SD and SW);

- 1. Major
- 2. Captain



NCC SGSITS

The NCC was started in SGSITS in 2013 under the 9 MP battalion. In the same year, Lt. Dr. Manish Jaiswal became an Associate NCC Officer. Mr. Nehru Dabar was given the responsibility of Senior Under Officer and he became the first Senior Under Officer of NCC at SGSITS. The NCC was started with a strength of 36 cadets at SGSITS. Currently, it has 102 cadets on roll. NCC SGSITS awards B and C certificates to cadets who successfully complete two and three years of training, respectively, and pass the exam conducted by NCC for each certificate. The cadets of the NCC take part in various events throughout the year organized by the 9 M.P. Battalion. Apart from this, various other activities are organized by the cadets on and off campus.






CATC - VII CAMP B-CERTIFICATE

TOPIC :- COMMUNICATION SKILLS BY LT. CDR. SADHANA GIRI (RETD.)


