2. CO-PO attainment of previous semester July- Dec 2023 (B.Tech. I Yr. & M.Sc. Appl. Chem. I Sem.) was discussed at the length & it was approved.
3. The possibility of functional MoUs/linkages with institutions/industries for internship, on-job training, project work, students/faculty exchange and collaborative research work were discussed and it is proposed to do it the current semester.
4. Syllabus of B.Tech I Yr. Chemistry was discussed at the length & changes were proposed to incorporate topics as per industry need. These changes are incorporated on the basis of the feedback received from students & faculty members and looking to the applied applications of fuel.
5. Syllabus of M.Sc. Appl. Chem. was discussed and no change was proposed.
6. The vision & mission of the department were discussed. All the members were agreed for minor change in vision statement. 6. The result & feedback analysis of previous semester were discussed & following suggestion were proposed:










- Conduction of remedial classes
