NATIONAL CADET CORPS

The National Cadet Corps is Youth Wing of Armed Forces with its Headquarters at New Delhi, India. It is open to school and college students on voluntary basis.

National Cadet Corps is a Tri-Services Organization, comprising the Army, Navy and Air Wing, engaged in grooming the youth of the country into disciplined and patriotic citizens. The National Cadet Corps in India is a voluntary organization which recruits cadets from high schools, colleges and universities all over India. The Cadets are given basic military training in small arms and parades. The officers and cadets have no liability for active military service once they complete their course.

The NCC is the world's largest uniformed youth organization. Its motto is 'Unity and Discipline'.

The NCC in India was formed the National Cadet Corps Act of 1948. In 1954 the existing tricolour flag was introduced. The three colours in the flag depict the three services in the Corps, red for Army, deep blue for Navy and light blue for the Air Force.

The NCC is headed by a Director General with the rank of Lieutenant General.

The organisational structure continues as follows;

- Directorate - There are 17 Directorates located in the state capitals headed by an officer of the rank of a Maj Gen from the three Services.
- Division/ Regimental Corps There are 3 such Specialised Corps located in Mumbai, Delhi and Bangalore respectively. They are independent of the state directorate and report to the HQ. These divisions form the support function of the regular NCC. Each is headed by a Senior Under Officer- an equivalent rank of (Lt.) General. Internal Affairs, Administration, Development and Research: Lt. Gen. [SUO] Arvind Shekhar (New Delhi). Recruitment, Training, Media and HR: Lt. Gen. [SUO] Prithvi Pant Negi (Mumbai). Special Forces, Infantry, Gallantry Committee & Commendations; Lt. Gen. [SUO] Bhav Salimath (Bangalore).
- Group - Depending upon the size of the state and growth of NCC in the states, Directorates have up to 14 Group Headquarters under them through which they exercise their command and control of the organisation in the state. Each group is headed by an officer of the rank of Brigadier or equivalent known as Group Commander.

- Battalion- Each NCC Group Headquarters control 5-7 units(Bns) commanded by Colonel/Lt. Col or equivalent.

- Each Battalion consists of companies which are commanded by the Associate NCC Officer (ANO) of the rank of lieutenant to major.

In all there are 96 Group Headquarters in the country who exercise control over a network of 684 Army wing units (including technical and \$1s' unit), 60 Naval wing units and 61 Air Squadrons. There are two training establishments namely Officers Training School, Kamptee (Nagpur, Maharashtra) and Women Officers Training School, Gwalior. Besides this Vice Chancellor's of various universities across India. are conferred with honorary rank of commandant in NCC, to promote and support NCC in their respective University.

For Army Wing each battalion or unit of NCC consists of a number of platoons or coy. For senior division boys each platoon consists of 52 cadets and each coy consists 160 cadets. Each BN has 4 to 7 coys so each BN carries around 640 to 1120 cadets. A senior wing girls BN consists of 2 to 7 coy means a total of 320 to 1120 cadets. For junior division boys and junior wing girls each troop has 100 cadets and each BN has at least one troop.

ANO is an important link in the NCC organization between the BN and the cadets. As a matter of fact, ANO is the feeder node of NCC since he / she is the one who is in direct contact with the cadets all throughout the year.

Associate NCC officers are given following ranks according to their seniority and their training.

NCC @ SGSITS

NCC was started in SGSITS in 2013 under 9 MP battalion. Lt. Dr. Manish Jaiswal became Associate NCC Officer in the same year. Mr. Nehru Dabar was given the responsibility of Senior Under Officer and hence became the first Senior Under Officer of NCC at SGSITS. NCC was started with a strength of 36 cadets at SGSITS. Currently it has 106 cadets on roll. NCC @ SGSITS awards B and C certificates to cadets who successfully complete two and three years of training respectively and pass the exam conducted by NCC for each certificate. Cadets of NCC take part in various events throughout the year arranged by the 9 M.P. Battalion. Apart from this, various other activities are organized by the cadets in and outside campus.

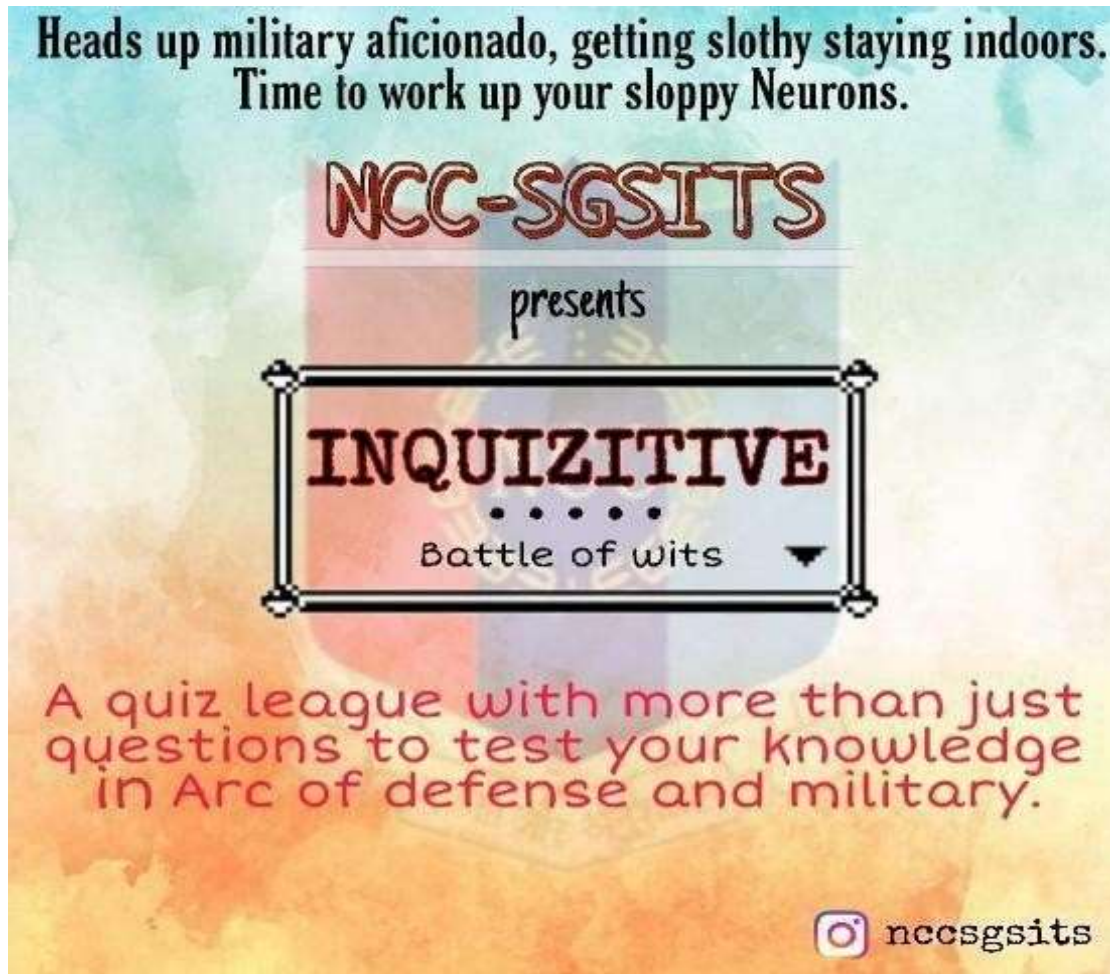




EVENTS

An online quiz competition was organized during the lockdown in which questions related to military background and current affairs were asked to the participants and top scorers were awarded.




- **Talent Hunt Competition (Online Event)**
