

# MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

AND

PRAKASH ASPHALTINGS & TOLL HIGHWAYS  
(I) Ltd, MHOW



This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is effective as of **June 22nd , 2021** (Effective Date) to establish an affiliation between **SHRI G.S. INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY & SCIENCE, Indore (SGSITS Indore M.P. 452003)**, prestigious institute in the field of engineering education and research, having its office at 23, Sir M. Visvesvaraya Marg, , Indore, hereinafter referred to as SGSITS, the “**FIRST PARTY**”, represented herein by its **Director (Dr. Rakesh Saxena)** (hereinafter referred as ‘**First Party**’, the institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators and assigns).

**AND**

**PRAKASH ASPHALTINGS & TOLL HIGHWAYS (India) Ltd, MHOW( Path India Ltd. MHOW Indore M.P. 453441 )** having its office at 76, Mall Road, MHOW, Dist. – Indore (M.P.) India – 453441, hereinafter referred to as PATH, the “**SECOND PARTY**”, and represented herein by its **Managing Director (Mr.Nitin Agarwal )** (hereinafter referred to as “**Second Party**”, company which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators and assigns).

For the purpose of training/exchange of resources (faculty/staff/student). The aforesaid parties are hereinafter referred to individually as party and collectively as parties.

SGSITS and PATH have many areas of common interest in Engineering Research and Training. In some of these areas, the degree of mutual interest is so great that considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, education, training and research. Collaboration will be established within the principles set out in the following sections.

#### **1. Object:**

Both SGSITS and PATH agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity. The two parties shall seek to promote:

#### **A. On the part of PATH: Field training/Education of students**

1. Training of Pre-Final and Final year Under graduate (Civil Engineering, Mechanical Engineering & Industrial Production Engineering) on various aspects of Road construction (Rigid and Flexible), Installation and Maintenance of Onsite Construction Plants/and Machinery, including working on live models and on site experience. (Batch size 25 students, Time duration 15 to 30 days).



1. paid internship in a group of 4-5 students for Undergraduate 1st year (Civil Engineering, Mechanical Engineering & Industrial Production Engineering) students for duration of 8-16 Weeks. Paid Internship & Job may be offered to the trainee if found suitable as per the Committee of Second Party. (Annexure I)
2. On job Training for Post graduate students (Civil Engineering, Mechanical Engineering & Industrial Production Engineering) under the Industrial training sub head of your curriculum.
3. Facilitate UG & PG Civil Engineering students to live projects for their Project Work.
4. The Second Party will provide infrastructure up-gradation support in the form of Training of Laboratory Assistants & Faculty of the Institute
5. Educational tours of students. (Annexure I)

### B. On The Part of SGSITS

1. To select students batches for training, internship and project work.
2. To formalize the training schedule according to the college academic calendar.
3. To facilitate and Invite PATH for Training and campus Placement.
4. To provide logistics support by way of use of its auditorium and other such facilities in case of lecture series or expert lectures organized by PATH in association with SGSITS.
5. Active Participation of Faculty and Technical Staff for purposes of curriculum development and review, upgrading of teaching and research skills.
6. Participating in seminars, symposiums, and other types of academic discussions.
7. To organize jointly seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein.

### 2. Coordination:

Each party shall appoint one member of its teaching/research faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Further, a coordination committee consisting of (a) Dean Training & Placements, (b) Head of Departments (Civil Engineering, Mechanical Engineering & Industrial Production Engineering) from the side of SGSITS and (c) General Manager Skill Development programme coordinator from the side of the second party, will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two parties.

### 3. Confidential Information:

SGSITS & PATH both will adhere to the confidentiality clause of any and every information shared during the tenure of this MOU as per the law of the land including the Intellectual Property Right.

### 4. Validity

The Memorandum shall remain in force for a period of 3 years commencing from effective date. The parties may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.

### 5. Termination

Either party may terminate the MoU by giving written notice of 1 month in advance to the other party once terminated; neither SGSITS nor PATH will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other parties may suffer. However, SGSITS and PATH will ensure that the provisions of this Memorandum shall continue to apply to all activities in progress until their completion.

### 6. Amendments/Modifications

This MoU may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both parties.



## 7. General points of agreement

Participating faculties, staff and students involved in any activities under this Memorandum must adhere to the law of the host countries and rules and regulations of the parties.

The MOU does not imply any kind of financial obligation, unless agreed upon in writing, on either side

And neither party can claim for any financial charges.

Nothing in this Memorandum shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the parties. This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.

Neither party shall be liable for any indirect, punitive, special, incidental or consequential damages arising out of or in connection with this understanding, whether for breach of this MOU or in torts, including loss of business, data, revenue and profits or for any third party claims against the other whatsoever.


Any and all the disputed, controversy or claims related to or arising in connection with this MOU shall be referred to Competent Authority of Parties for an informal solution.

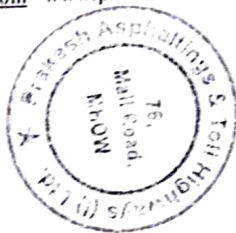

## ANNEXURE – I

### **(A) Paid Internship Programme for Engineering students**

Duration – 8- 16 weeks

Accommodation Facility should be arranged by Interns.

Students will only receive Morning and afternoon tea and lunch at the Internship location.

Rs. 5000/- Stipend will be given during the Paid Internship Period (as per attendance minimum 85%).

5. Interns will have to make their own arrangements to reach the camp site.

### **(B) For Employment**

Second Party's Recruitment/Placement/Selection committee shall follow the standard procedure of recruitment for any intern/ Trainee.

### **(C) Study Tour of Students**

1. Second Party will allow students to visit their site in a group of 15+ students.
2. For any site visit prior permission has to be taken by First Party (HOD of Respective Dept./TPO SGSITS).
3. For any visit to Training/Internship, all expenses (including lodging/Boarding/accommodation, food, etc.) shall be borne by the trainee.
